WHO ARE THE YOUNG GREENS?

The Young Greens are the youth and student branch of the Green Party.

We organise within and beyond the Green Party to work for the genuine, tangible political and social change necessary for young people.

The Young Greens lead the way in the Green Party; we are involved in every level of the organisation, ensure that activists are on the ground and push the party in an ever more progressive and forward thinking direction.

Working through both national campaigns and community activism, we strive to make a positive and strong impact on the political discourse on every level, shifting the debate towards the issues that matter to young people whilst presenting our vision of a just and sustainable future.

FREE EDUCATION

We want education that doesn't cost a penny, including scrapping all tuition fees, as well as providers that offer a youth-centred, individually tailored education throughout life.

SUSTAINABLE FUTURE

We want a greener future where the environment is supported, not abused, ensuring that we have a healthy planet to live on. We support a green jobs programme to develop our green technology and infrastructure across the country.



WHAT DO WE WANT?

EQUALITY

We want people to be recognised as equal to one another; socially, economically, politically. We celebrate diversity, and are unashamedly in support of the liberation of all oppressed groups.

PUBLIC NHS

We want services that are run for and by the people, with accessibility and quality of output as the priority, not profit. This includes a public NHS, education system and public transport networks.

HOW CAN YOU GET INVOLVED?

Young Greens are active around the country, running city, campus and regional groups to get together like-minded people. We campaign locally, run events, socialise and work with local Green Party groups to win elections.

GROUPS

EVENTS

The Young Greens' **Annual Convention** takes place in Autumn, where we run workshops, set priorities for the year, and elect the Young Greens' National Committee. Young Greens are also active at the twice-yearly national **Green Party Conference** as well as organising regular local, regional and national events.

SUPPORT & MENTORING

Each year, we run a **mentoring scheme** to help young people break into the Westminster bubble and gain the confidence and skills to represent the Green Party in the future. Along with this, we organise **buddying schemes** at Green Party events, and serve as the central point of contact for Young Greens who want to get further involved in the party.
